Congratulations and thank you for purchasing Enchanted Self Promo Poster!

An enchanting poster, with moving elements, perfect for showing off your magical powers! Maybe you're a wizard with web, or a demon designer – put yourself onto the most mystical wanted list with this spellbinding template.

Graphics on the poster start out invisible and appear, as if by magic, using ink blots. Use of rain sound effects make it look like the graphics appear when exposed to water. Place your own moving video into the file to achieve the look of a Harry Potter style 'wanted' poster!

Features :

- No plugins required
- After Effects CS5
- No 3D elements
- High Definition 1080p
- PDF FAQ guide and PDF guide for text placeholders

The After Effects project file has colour coded, marked layers which guide you in the right direction when trying to edit the significant elements. (See Point 'What can I edit?')

The fonts used in the preview I chose specifically for this project, because of their appearance. They are free fonts 'Cairo' and 'Poster Slab Caps' and can be downloaded from <http://www.dafont.com>.

Where do I start?

Go straight to the folder _EDIT THESE to enter your own text, logo and URL and add, perhaps, a crazy video of yourself looking silly! Or just a photo!

Please refer to the handy PDF entitled 'Poster_Text_Guide.pdf' when figuring out where to place your text, and in which composition.

Alternatively you can begin with the composition _Enchanted Self Promo Poster and double-click the BLUE layers until you reach a RED layer, which is an editable layer.

What can I edit?

Layers are colour-coded as follows:

Green	Information
Red	Edit in this Composition (you can edit this layer directly here, it will affect the sequence globally)
Blue	Edit in Pre-Composition (double-click this layer until you reach a Red layer)
Brown	No need to change (try not to make changes to these layers as they will adversely affect the sequence)
