Upward Motion is a simple, yet elegant, gallery of image panels which smoothly slide up over each other as the sequence progresses. Every third slide contains an editable text spot. There are 36 image placeholders, 12 of which have placeholders for text.

No extra plugins are required.

The project is typeset using a traditional serif font but you can, of course, choose to use a more modern typeface, if your project requires.

02 // Editing Text

In the Project panel open the folder **01. Edit Comps / Text**

In here are all the editable text compositions for the project. Open each one individually and edit the text, from the marker “EDIT HERE” – this is the point which all the elements have animated on.

Only 12 of the (36) image panels have overlayed text. These are referenced by the composition *names* (eg. “**Text 01 Appears on Image 03**”).

03 // Adding Images

In the Project panel open the folder **01. Edit Comps / Images**

In here are all the editable image compositions for the project. Open each one individually and add your photos.

Ensure to fill the entire composition with your image.

05 // Rendering

To render simply drop the composition **02. Final Comp / Final Comp** into the Render Queue and choose your desired output settings.

Hit render !
